Samrakshak samuha nepal (sasane) is an Organization driven by the power of survivors Of human trafficking that envisions a world Where no one is exploited for sex trade, forced Labor or domestic servitude. The name "samrakshak samuha" translates to "A team of protectors."

VISION

Each survivor is equipped with self-esteem, skills, and knowledge to achieve her dream and potential to become a leader in her chosen field. SASANE works on the principle that trafficking survivors can band together to protect their futures by empowering themselves and pursuing social change.

Mission

End physical and sexual exploitation of women and girls, ensuring their legal rights, and empowering them to live free and dignified lives by increasing women's access to justice, concluding ultimate goal of ending human trafficking in Nepal and reintegration of survivors into society and their communities.



Objectives

- To eradicate human trafficking and re-integrate human trafficking survivors into their society as respected members.
- To increase women's access to justice and achieve systemic change within the legal system.

WHAT WE DO ?

Since its establishment in 2008, SASANE has been advocating for rights of trafficking survivors and is working to eliminate the heinous crime by raising awareness, improving education, ensuring empowerment and sustainable reintegration of survivors who become active leaders in their chosen field.

Every year since its establishment, SASANE has enrolled and trained survivors of trafficking in subsidiary legal matters to meet the dual objective of reintegrating them into the society and improving access to justice for other victims under its **Paralegal Training Program**.


The Mountain Village Education Program goes beyond its primary objective of educating women and children in remote mountainous villages of Nepal. It also aims to aid in promoting health, hygiene, and economy of the communities we work in.

Education is the key to empowering girls and breaking the cycle of abuse they have endured. At the same time, it is also important to sensitize the community so they can reintegrate in the society. The **School for Justice Program**, seeks to address both of these concerns.




SASANE's Women and Children Helpline Service - 16600130013

provides 24 hour free urgent legal information and guidance to needful victims or general public on issues concerning human trafficking, sexual abuse/violence, domestic violence and child marriage. The helpline service is implemented in needful coordination with Nepal Police and other civil society organizations working in the issue of women and children.





OUR IMPACT



These paralegals offered free assistance to victims to report and write applications at the police station. They helped report 13,000 cases during their internship, which resulted in 415 court cases.

SASANE was able to draw attention of school management and government so that there is an open environment to discuss issues and problems of child marriage. We were able to reach 200 students in 3 public schools, one in each district of Kathmandu Valley, and Nuwakot.

SASANE's Beneficiaries stepped out from their comfort zone to become spokesperson in Free a Girl's **"Voice for Justice"** Campaign. They will fight against the impunity and place the perpetrators behind bar.

Half-day sensitization trainings were provided twice to police officers on child trafficking and child protection to 416 police officers and 7 District Attorneys from Kathmandu, Bhaktapur, Lalitpur, Kaski, Sindhupalchowk, Dhading and Nuwakot on child trafficking and child protection.
